POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics at the University of California, Davis, invites applications for business law lecturers during the 2006-2008 academic years. The department's undergraduate major in Managerial Economics is one of the largest on the Davis campus.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Teach one or more undergraduate business law lecture courses in the Managerial Economics major, depending on programmatic need and the candidate's availability. Duties include full responsibility for course presentation, including, but not limited to, lectures, preparation and grading of exams, office hours outside of class time, and supervision of teaching assistants or readers if assigned. Duration of appointment will depend on number of courses assigned; percentage of appointment is 44%.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

The criterion for appointment is evidence of teaching excellence and expertise in the subject area. Individuals recruited should possess a post-baccalaureate degree in the relevant subject matter area or equivalent advanced coursework and professional experience. University-level teaching experience is also highly desirable.

The following course may be offered by lecturers for the 2006-2008 academic years (number of units in parentheses, followed by quarter traditionally taught):
