POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics at the University of California, Davis, invites applications for lecturer positions during the 2007-08 academic year. The department's undergraduate major in Managerial Economics is one of the largest on the Davis campus.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Teach one or more undergraduate lecture courses in the Managerial Economics major, depending on programmatic need and candidate's expertise and availability. Duties will include full responsibility for course presentation, including, but not limited to, lectures, preparation and grading of exams, office hours outside of class time, and supervision of teaching assistants or readers if assigned. The percentage and duration of appointment will depend on number of courses assigned and the number of units per course.

Individuals recruited should possess a post-baccalaureate degree in the relevant subject matter area or equivalent advanced coursework and professional experience. University-level teaching experience is also highly desirable.
